Location: **Caerleon Roman Ruins Walk**

Directions: Set sat nav for Caerleon. This is a possible walk you could do on the way to or from the castle as it involves heading towards Newport.

Parking: Free where we were

Pop in to: Within 50 yards walking distance: Caerleon Roman Legion museum and (in a separate building, walking further along the road into town) the Caerleon Fortress Baths. Both Museum and Baths buildings are 'free entry' with the usual tourist shops.



Description: Lots of interesting roman museums and a large amphitheatre. Our dogs had a good run all around with no restrictions. There is a Roman Barracks here and at one point they had over 3,000 troops stationed here. For their entertainment they built this very large amphitheatre – a sort of mini Colosseum and the largest most intact such building in Britain.

After a walk around the barracks, you can cross the car parking area into the Amphitheatre, probably the best preserved and largest intact amphitheatre in Britain.
