

Walk:	EOC 14
<u>Location:</u>	<u>Maerdy Mountain Walk (A4233 between Aberdare & Maerdy)</u>
Directions:	Proceed via Glynneath towards Merthyr Tydfill on A465. Set your sat nav for Maerdy. Turn right at 2 nd roundabout after Glynneath, off A465, to Aberdare and from Aberdare take A4233 to Maerdy. Park on the forest track parking areas just before you descend into Maerdy itself.

Length of Walk:	Some go on for hours and are non-circular. Others can be done as one hour circular walks.
Dates Walked:	06/03/2010
Parking:	Free
Pop in to:	Back streets of Maerdy to see a range of typical back to back miners' Welsh terraced houses.
Description:	Most of these tracks would be suitable for mountain biking or a Segway. Long forest paths and wide tracks, plus some minor tracks. At least three maybe four different parking areas, each with its own woodland walks, many with good views. Useful as a stop off walk if travelling with dogs to from the castle to Cardiff, or if you fancy doing a tour of the Rhonnda Valley.
